A member of staff with First Aid training assessed your child. Although no serious problems were seen at the time, we suggest you keep a close eye on your child for the next 48 hours for any of the following symptoms:

- Severe headache
- Blurred vision
- Hearing loss
- Any problem with the senses
- Unusual drowsiness
- Change in behaviour

- Confusion (getting things muddled up)
- Nausea or repeated vomiting
- Clumsy walking, staggering, dizziness, weakness
- Slurred Speech
- Bleeding or fluid from the ears or nose
- Unresponsiveness

Contact your family doctor or accident and emergency department immediately if you notice any of the above symptoms.
